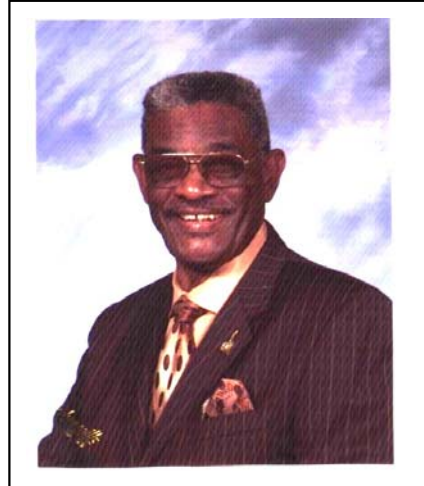

ABOUT THE FACILITATOR

JOSEPH C. WALSH, JR.

Joseph Walsh, Jr. has served as a gospel minister for more than 40 years for congregations in California, Arizona, Florida and Texas. He has conducted numerous gospel and revival meetings, family and congregational seminars both nationally and internationally. He has been active in foreign missions in Guyana, South America and Nassau, Bahamas. He has participated on Forums and Lectureships on ten Caribbean Islands. Also, in addition with his evangelistic work, he has served as a religious counselor assisting individuals, couples and families. His educational background includes college credits along with extensive religious training in the church setting. He has been married to his wife, Wilma for 54 years. They have three daughters, eight grand, five great grandchildren; a deceased son.

As of August 7, 2011, Brother Walsh is retired from the daily pulpit and pastoral duties to the newly ordained Courtney Caruthers. He is transitioning to assist congregations and ministers who desire the learned skills of a senior minister in programs of congregational leadership, administration, evangelism, family, edification and Church Growth.

CONGREGATIONAL ENHANCEMENT SEMINARS

Church Leadership Development Seminar. This workshop examines how effective congregational leadership is developed. Using New Testament teaching, strategies are provided for identifying, training, developing, and implementing strong congregational leadership. The role of evangelist, elders and deacons is discussed. The Church “corporate” structure which is required by most states in the United States for maintaining non-profit status is explored as well. These are very interactive sessions and a must for newly formed or small congregations who have yet to select elders and future leaders.

Areas For Discussion: Biblical Pattern for Leadership - The Relationship of Men and Women in the Local Church - The Christian Man as a Leader of Christians - The Work of the Evangelist - The Role of the Elder - The Role of the Deacon - Dynamics of Church Leadership

Bible School Teacher's Seminar. These highly interactive sessions focus on the development of effective and efficient Sunday School teachers at all levels within a congregation. Necessary characteristics for teacher selection and evaluation are discussed. Effective organization and structuring of congregational educational programs are provided.

Areas For Discussion: The Work of the Educational Director - Teaching Program of the Early Church - What is Expected of Teachers - Teaching for Positive Results - How To Research and Outline A Section of Scripture - The Lesson Plan - Seven Laws of Teaching - More

Financial Stewardship Seminar. This session explores the issues related to financial stewardship for both the congregation and individuals. New Testament teaching is used to develop a foundation for improving stewardship activities.

Areas for Discussion: Your Money Talks - God's Plan for Giving, Old & New Testament - What Is Benevolence? - Giving Account of Your Stewardship - More

Evangelism Seminar. A presentation designed to enhance evangelism and outreach efforts for local congregations. A hands on –How-to-Do It Door to Door. This Seminar assists leaderships in developing effective methods for evangelizing in targeted communities and geographic areas.

Areas for Discussion: Challenge to do Personal Work - The Bible and Personal Evangelism – Techniques in Personal Evangelism - The Approach and Appointment Problem- More

Church Growth Workshop. Interactive session aimed at assessing ways to manage church growth. Factors that impact how congregations increase in size and complexity are examined. Members responsibilities for personal growth are examined.

Areas for Discussion: Growing in the Grace and Knowledge of Jesus Christ - Zone Program – Discipleship-Developing Christlikeness – Church at Work Activity Booklet – More

FAMILY LIFE SEMINAR

Marriage Enrichment. This workshop examines the challenges to Christian Family Life and provides Biblical strategies for addressing them. Family structure issues are explored during this highly interactive four –to-six day workshop. A 60 page work-booklet entitled, Keys to the Masterlock of Family and Wedlock is the center piece for this workshop. A 55-minute video for teenagers and parents entitled, Sex, Love and Relationship is viewed and discussed. Power-point Presentation. Sermons that accompany workshop, What's Love Got to Do With It? – Except the Lord Build the House – Inmates, Roommates or Soul Mates – Steps to a Successful Marriage - More

Areas for Discussion. What Marriage is All About! – God's Plan for the Family – The Blended/Step Family –The Role of the Husband/Wife in Making Christian Marriage Succeed – Communications In Marital Relationships – Keeping Romance in Marriage, Human Sexuality - (R-rated –under 17 not permitted without parent of guardian) - Much More.

Singles Workshop. This session takes a very strong Biblical approach to how single members of the Church of Christ must navigate “single life” in a highly secular world. Tips and strategies for dating and finding a Christian mate are examined during these sessions. It is very interactive. **Areas for Discussion.** Single by Choice – Single After Marriage- Confronting the Myths of Single Parenting – Moms Raising Boys Without a Father- Ten Prerequisites for Separated Dad – Much more.

The above Seminars can be presented in any order or for any amount of sessions deemed appropriate for the needs of the local congregation.
